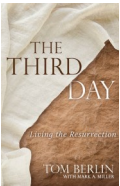
Title: "Made Known"

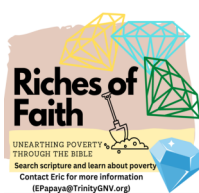
Wednesday Night Dinner, Classes & Worship

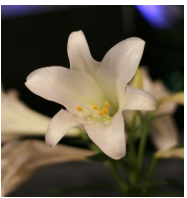
Trinity Bookstore

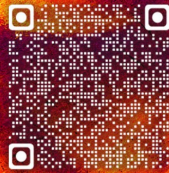
