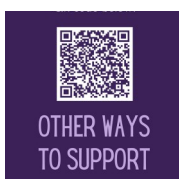

Creation Care



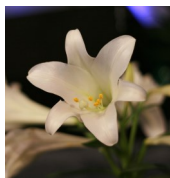

Easter Lily Dedications



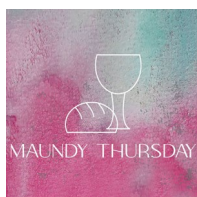

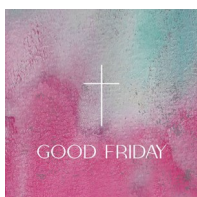
Maundy Thursday Dinner and Worship Experience - March 28, 6:00 pm, Worship Center



Maundy Thursday is part of the Christian celebration of Easter and marks the night of the Last Supper as told in Scripture. Before the dinner, Jesus washed the feet of his disciples and said, "A new commandment* I give you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another." (John 13:34)

This worship service will include dinner prepared by our Food Hospitality Coordinator, Missi Newbauer, as part of a worship experience. **Reservations are required and can be made by going to trinitygnv.org/easter.** *(The word Maundy is from the Old French mande, in turn from the Latin mandatum, which means mandate or command).
